*you will need:* 6-sided dice, 10 colored counters per person (different colors than each other)  
*directions:* Players take turns rolling the dice and moving that number of spaces. The player names the fraction represented by the picture, and covers the fraction in the middle of the game board with a counter or token. If the other player has a counter on that fraction, you can **BUMP** them off the space and put your own counter. If you already have your own counter on the space, you can add another on top **LOCKING** that space. No more counters can be added or bumped from that space. The winner of the game is the first to use all 10 counters. **\*\*If you land on a space with a KID holding a fraction, you get to cover that fraction AND any other space!\*\***
